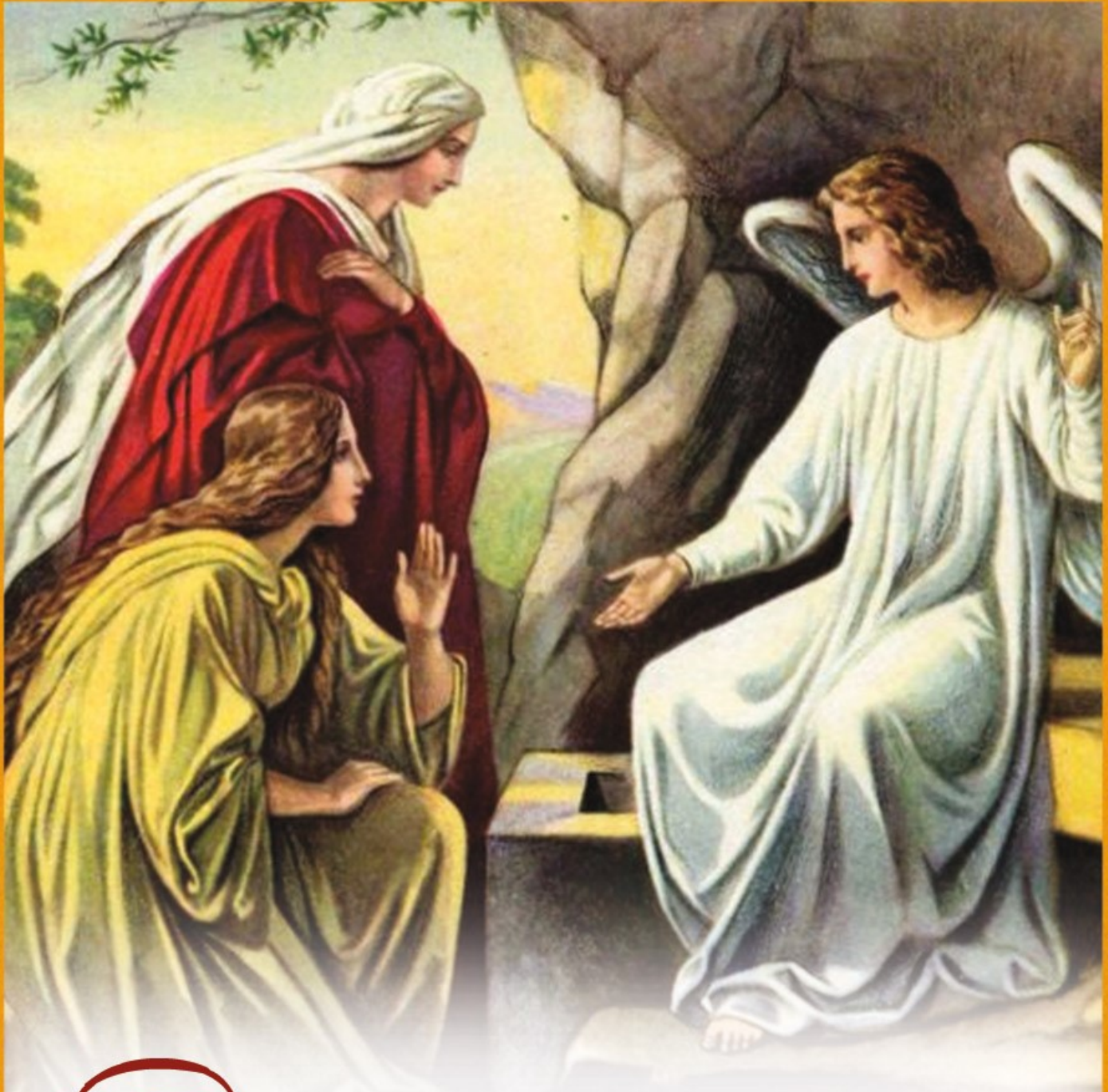

## *AN EASTER MESSAGE*

Easter 2019—We have come again, having traveled through the Holy Season of Lent, to the celebration of the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, the Father's definitive confirmation and vindication of the Son's call to self-sacrificial love, His devotion to the Truth, and the means whereby our Salvation is secured. If Jesus of Nazareth had been crucified and consigned without release to the tomb, then as Saint Paul reminds us, we are the most pitiable of fools for our faith is in vain. But as the Risen Lord, He has an absolute claim upon our lives, upon our very being. The Joy of Easter should inspire us all to deepen our faith and our courage to live in the world and proclaim the Good News that all may share the joy of Christ in His Church.
