NORTHERN CAMBRIA CATHOLIC SCHOOL registration for students whose parents wish to enroll their children in grades pre-kindergarten through eighth grade is being held at NCCS for the 2011/2012 school year. Registration will be held on Monday, January 31 from 2 PM to 7 PM in the school office or you can call for an appointment at another day and time.

Requirements

Kindergarten – Children who will be five (5) years of age by September 30th can be admitted to kindergarten. A birth certificate, immunization record, social security card and baptismal certificate are required. A non-refundable registration fee of \$30.00 is due and will be credited to your 2011/2012 tuition.

First grade students who will be six (6) by September 30th can be admitted to grade 1. A Readiness Test is required prior to admission. An immunization record, birth certificate, baptismal certificate, social security card and registration fee are required.

Preschool children must be three (3) by September 30th and potty trained. Registration Fee of \$30 is required. Bus transportation is not provided.
