### Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With Advent approaching there have been ongoing discussions about our liturgical life and schedule. I appreciate all of you who were invested enough to take the time to share your opinions about Mass options. I did request from Bishop Mark permission to offer a fourth Mass on Sunday evening at 7:00 p.m. and while he did note that there was a need, he asked that I not institute that until further discussion with the diocese and other priests in the deanery. I do think that it would be a much-needed addition to our worship schedule, offering primarily younger people an opportunity to worship with us. They are our future and I'm not comfortable with consigning them to go find another parish. With that said below is our liturgical schedule to begin the first Sunday of Advent with the Vigil Mass on the first of December. Of all that we do as a parish, no matter how worthwhile our other endeavors, devotionals or services, the worship of God in the context of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is by far the most important and is the heart of this Parish community.
